## Putnam Camp COVID-19 Policy – 2023 Season

For the 2023 season, Putnam Camp will not be requiring that you and your party provide proof of COVID-19 vaccination when making a reservation, and will not require a negative COVID-19 test result prior to your arrival at camp.

However, Putnam Camp continues to place a high priority on protecting the health and safety of all guests and staff. Therefore we ask you to prepare for your visit to Camp by taking the following precautions to reduce the risk of exposure to others:

- 1) Please pack high-quality masks and COVID-19 tests (2 tests/person) for use in the event of illness or exposure.
- 2) Contact the managers immediately if you or any member of your party develop symptoms of illness while at Camp. The Managers will ask that any guest with symptoms test for Covid and share test results with the Managers. If a member of your party tests positive for Covid, your entire party will be asked to isolate, mask and test.
- 3) Please be prepared to shorten your stay in the event you or a member of your party develops COVID-19 symptoms or tests positive while at Camp. Isolation protocols span 5 days or more and the Camp is not prepared to support guests while they are in isolation.
- 4) If you and your party have not yet arrived, the Managers will present you with options for adjusting your travel plans and confirming that you and your party are healthy prior to arriving at Camp.
